Exterior formerly painted white with green trim. Interior is unfinished--exposed lath in all rooms except kitchen.\* Woodwork unfinished throughout. Kitchen covered with narrow tongue & groove boards, as are ceilings in downstairs rooms.

Basement under kitchen only, may have been a springhouse or dairy. Garage east of house.

\* Jim Gossom and Mrs. Padgett state that the house was wallpapered over the lath, never plastered.

Interior inspected? Yes.

Historical significance (Chain of title; individuals, families, events, etc., associated with the property.)

Property was probably part of Evergreen Plantation. From late 19th century to early 20th century, it was the residence of storekeeper W.T. Gossom and family. Store, q.v., located at the entrance to driveway leading to house.

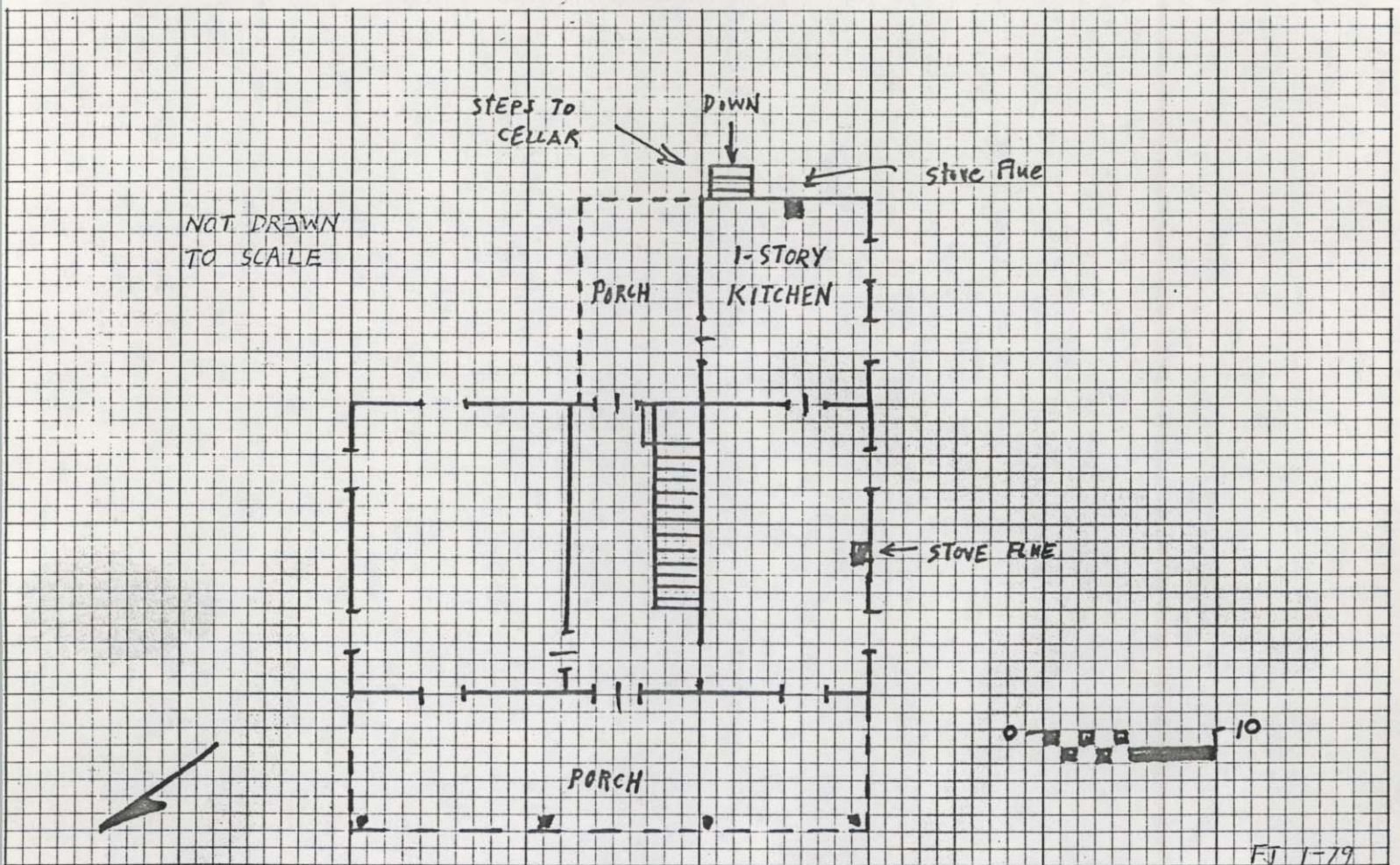
