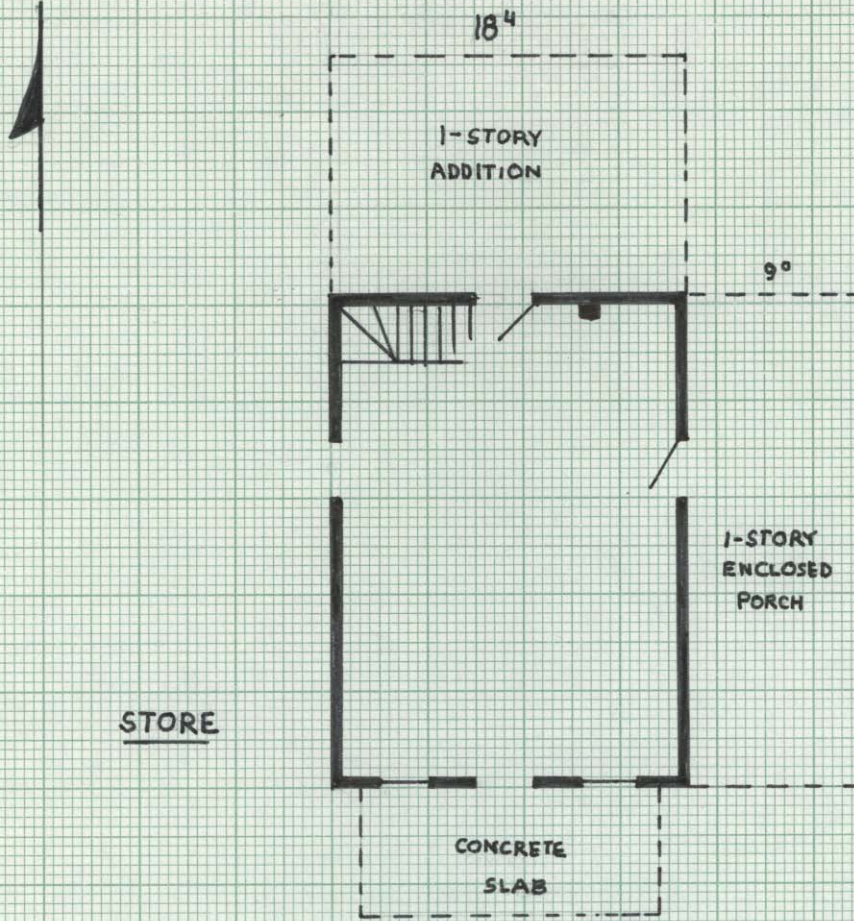
H.G. Store was run by Mr. Galleher
