

John Graham (1711 - 1787) probably emigrated  
to Virginia <sup>c1740</sup> about the same time as John Carlyle  
He was a merchant from Dumfries, Scotland, <sup>though he had been born in</sup>

Graham  
took out  
his

1st land grant in 1741 on Goose Creek.  
had 5 land grants altogether, 3 on Goose Creek,  
2 on Iwantis.

The Iwantis land grants

- 1744 Grant patented by tract on s. side  
of Iwantis Ck. a part of which is  
the Graham Park subdivision.
- 1746 136 acres on north side  
of Iwantis Ck. where Dumfries was  
established in 1748.

John Graham was Clerk of Fairfax County  
1746-1752

John Graham was Clerk of the Prince  
William County 1752-1777

His son Robert Graham (1751-1821) was  
Clerk 1777-1795.
