

GRAHAM PARK

Just east of this location along the
Quantico Creek was the plantation known
as Graham Park. The property was
patented by John Graham (1711-1787)
who came to Virginia from Scotland ^{about} ~~1733~~
1733 ~~1740~~. Graham is known as the founder of
Dumfries since the town sprang to life
from 60 acres taken from his plantation
in 1749. He was a successful merchant
trustee of Dumfries, and County Clerk.
