Exterior <sup>Coursed + uncoursed</sup> Sandstone <sup>rubble</sup> with stone (interior) end chimneys;  
metal roof, box cornice. Windows: 6/6 ~~pane~~ sash.  
1 1/2 story frame kitchen <sup>el</sup> w/ stone stack.

Foundation for 1-story porch across front. Shutter fixtures,  
but shutters not present.

Interior Room A (Livingroom) <sup>15' x 21'</sup> Fireplace - <sup>Simple</sup> ~~thin~~ mantel shelf;  
~~moulded~~ cornice & ~~simple moulded~~ frieze. Raised stone  
hearth. Small section of orig. chair-rail at A-3.

A-1: Location of former staircase. A-2: Location of  
earlier door, now a window. Doors: 6 paneled; box locks.

Room B (Parlor) <sup>14' x 15'</sup> Mantel - Late Federal Period -  
Moulded shelf; paneled [fireboard?]; moulded architrave;  
(opening surrounded by pilasters)  
Flanking <sup>double</sup> chimney closets with <sup>double</sup> paneled doors.

Room C (Passage) <sup>8' x 15'</sup> Stair: Open, winding; square  
newel with 2 sq. <sup>rails</sup> balusters per stair.

Room D (Kitchen) <sup>brick-sealed</sup> 16' x 22' Stone, fireplace, mantel  
missing. ~~F.P. sealed w~~

### Room D

D-1: Closed, winding s.c. to finished attic now used as for storage. (2 steps lead to door to)

D-2: Batten door with wooden box lock

D-3: Former window location (approx.) Window to R. is replacement.

D-4: These two windows both new.

Outbuildings:  
Former meat-house behind (kitchen. 20<sup>th</sup> c. carriage house sweet of main house.

2d Floor 3 bedrooms - 1 large over parlor; 2 smaller over living room. 2 Fireplaces upstairs, one in each of the end rooms.

Wood: Replacement pine floor in LR. 4-5" W random L pine in parlor and upstairs L. 5" W oak or chestnut floor in 2 rooms over L.R. Doors, trim, chair rail & window frames prop. pine.
