The Kerr heirs, James William Kerr and Ethel Kerr own the property now. The Kerr family purchased the property in 1903 from R B Abel. Abel purchased it from W. H. Keys. (DB 52 p. 95). At that time it was $28\frac{3}{4}$ acres. Keys had obtained it in 1900 from William Groves. W^m Groves, eldest son of Henry Groves, acquired the property from his sisters, co-heirs.

The Groves are buried in the Triangle Cemetery 0.1 mi. S. of Triangle.

Henry Groves (1784-1865) may have purchased the property in 1824 or 1826 from Thomas Triplett + wife Ann. At that time the land totaled 164 acres with an additional 15 acres.
