2d floor good offices.

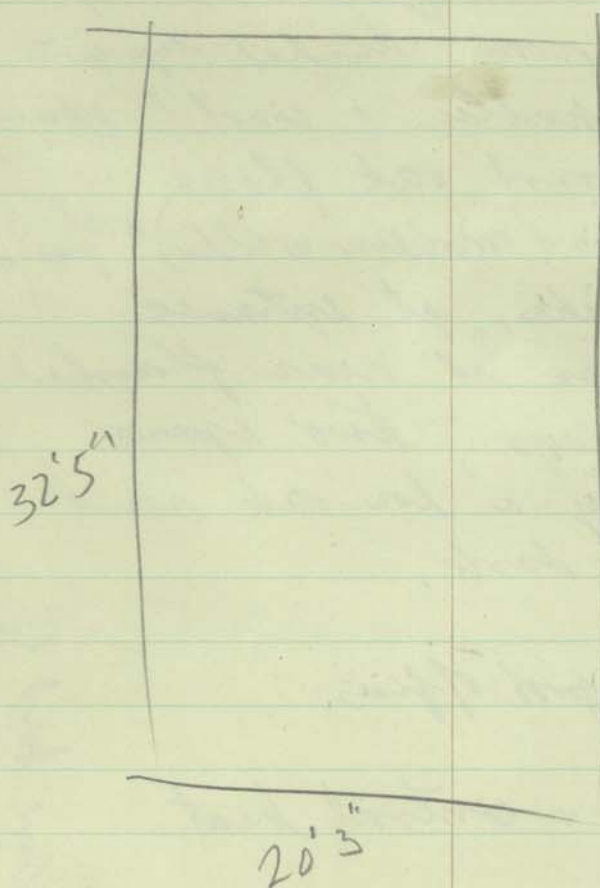
air cond + central heat.

plain trim

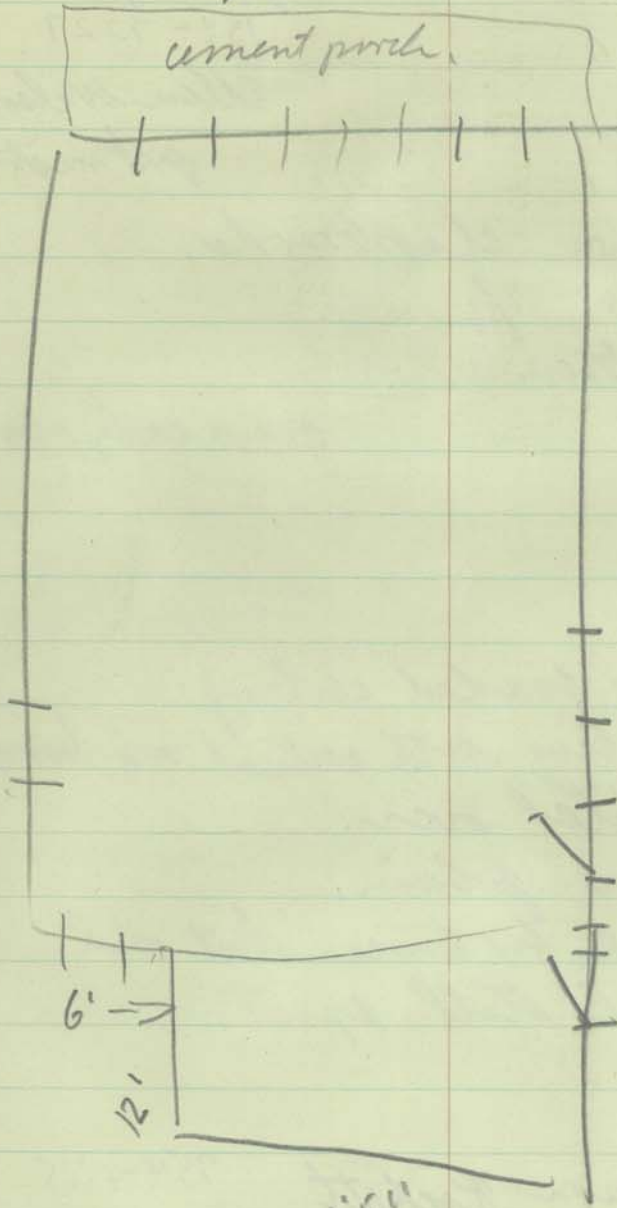
