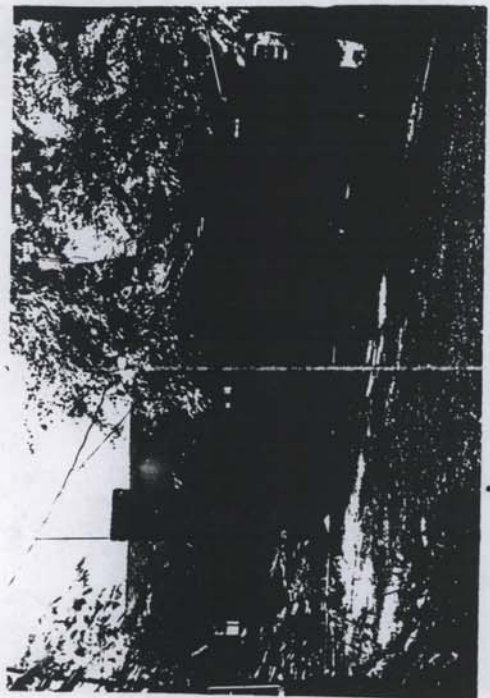

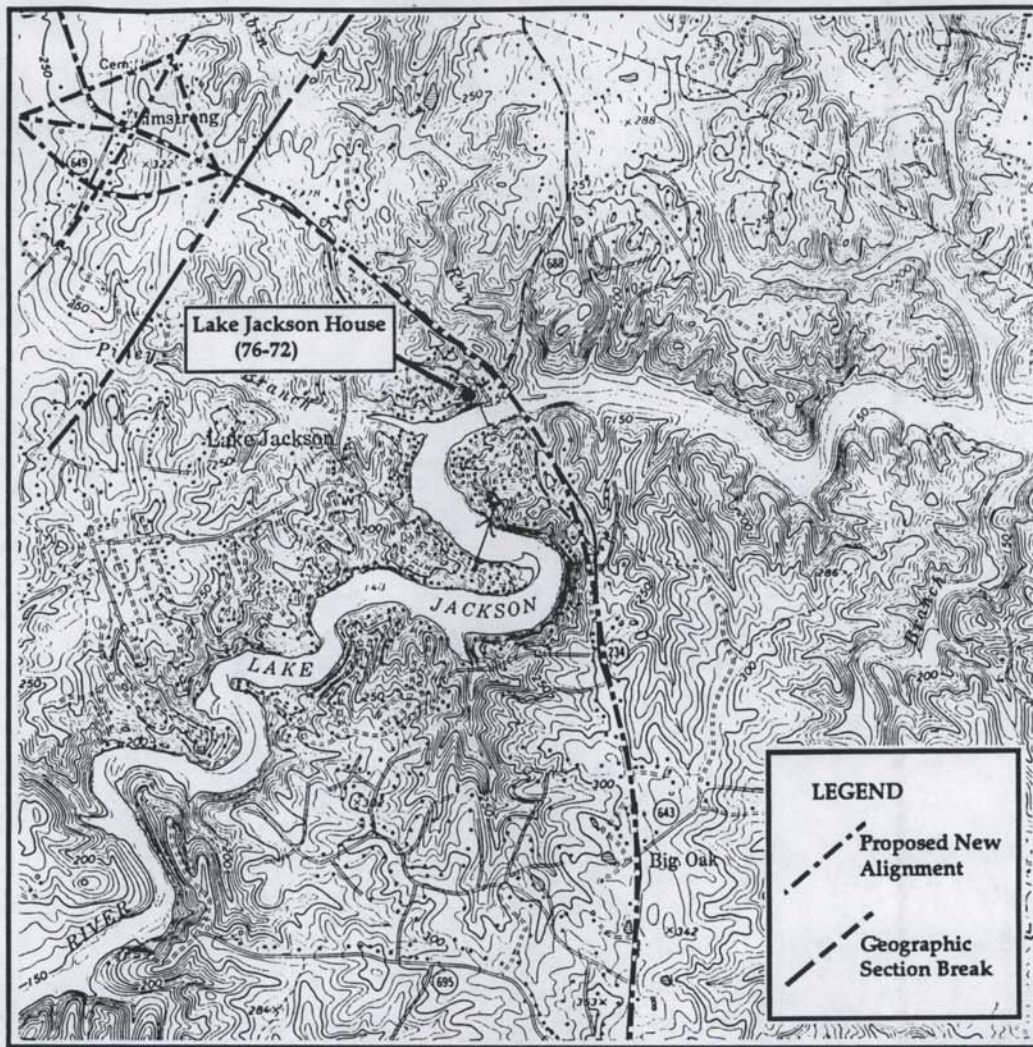


Figure 35: Proposed Manassas Bypass, Southern Section Showing Lake Jackson and Lake Jackson House (76-72)

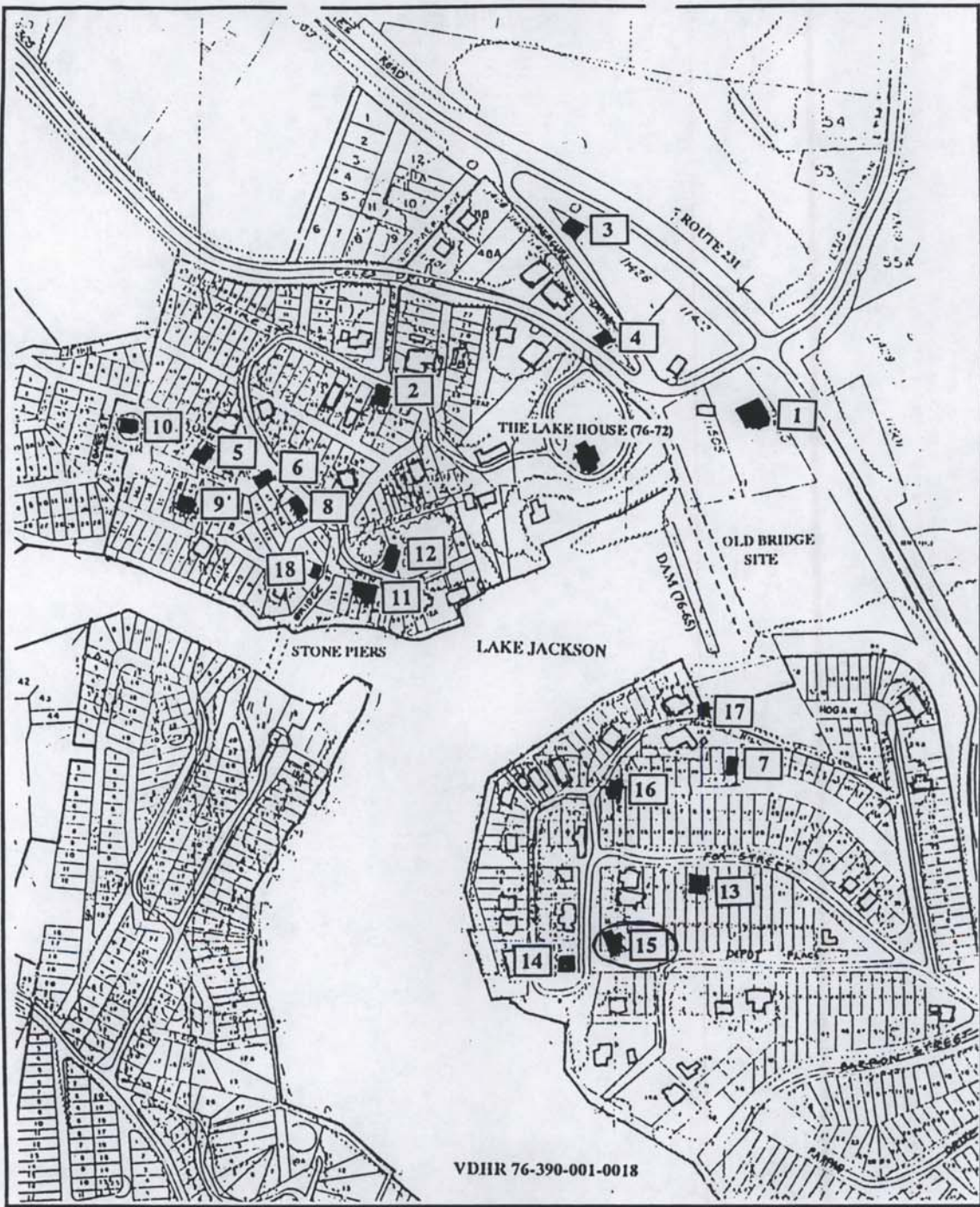
