by C.W. Albaugh in the 1930's.

Began in 1927 on 500 acres. Started
building a dam to create a lake.

In 1929, when dam was 75% compl.,
Va Public Service took it over +
finished the dam.

The resort community became a
year-round residence for many of
the purchasers.
