

Marker dedicated to patriot Henry Lee II of Leesylvania

The Sons of the American Revolution organization invites the public to honor the memory of Henry Lee II of Leesylvania by the placing of a marker at his gravesite. A Revolutionary War color guard with fife and drum will be present.

As leader of the Prince William Militia, Henry Lee II led his troops in improving the road across the Occoquan River used by the baggage and supply wagons of the French and American armies, who then met Washington and Rochambeau's troops at Dumfries for the march to Yorktown on the Old Kings Highway.

At Yorktown, Cornwallis's British Army surrendered and the American Revolution was over. Sections of the Old Kings Highway still are present in Prince William County today and are a reminder of America's independence and of the role Prince William County played in that fight for freedom.
