- Nuns were given a part of land

on cond. they open a school
for poor girls - ^{became the} Orphanage for
Catholic diocese in Va.

ST. Joseph's School
Group of Rel. men had the boys school.
in c. 1922, the men left the area
& turned over their land on the
condition. 1893

girls school is in Richmond.
& is called St Anne's.

In the 1920's orphanage was
moved to Richmond.

facility, Georgetown M.
brought corps out for
weekend retreat 1950s +
1960s. but recently
not enough people to staff
St. Anne's.
