


Directions From Henry Hill Visitor Center

Stuart's Hill:

Turn right out of the Visitor Center driveway onto Rt. 234 N. At the first Traffic light turn left ont Rt. 29W. Proceed approximately 2 1/2 miles. Look for the "Stuart's Hill Overlook" sign. Turn left onto Pageland Ln. and left again into driveway.

Portici:

Turn left out of the Visitor Center driveway. At the first traffic light turn left onto Battleview Pkwy. Proceed to Strayer College (on the left) park at the back of the lot.

July 24&25 1999

Guided Walking Tours

• Henry Hill Tour 30 minutes 10:15, 11:15, 1:15

Provides an overview of the first major battle of the Civil War on the ground where the battle was decided.

Stone Bridge Tour 90 minutes 2:00 pm

This tour meets at Stop #12 (you must drive there). Walk the Confederate defensive line where the first shots of the battle were fired.

Sudley Tour 90 minutes 3:00 pm

This tour meets at the Sudley Church (you must drive there). Follow in the footsteps of the Union flanking column after it crosses Bull Run and it's impact on the wartime community of Sudley.

Matthews Hill Tour 60 minutes 4:00 pm

This tour meets at Stop # 3 (you must drive there). Provides an overview of the Confederate forces interception of the Union flanking column.

Living History Programs

Cavalry Program 30 minutes 11:00, 2:00

This program is given at "Portici" (you must drive there). The 4th Virginia Cavalry will present a program on the history and use of cavalry during the Civil War while demonstrating field tactics.

Infantry Encampment 10:00-4:00

The encampment is located at Stuart's Hill (you must drive there). The 14th Brooklyn Infantry will provide insight into the daily routine of the Civil War soldier.

Infantry Program 30 minutes 1:00, 3:00

This program is given at "Stuart's Hill." (you must drive there) The 14th Brooklyn will present a program on infantry tactics with the use of a musket firing demonstration.

Grand Concert July 24th only 6:00 pm - 8:00 pm

This program is given at "Stuart's Hill" (you must drive there). Bring a picnic dinner and join the Wildcat Regiment Band for Civil War music on the battlefield.

Candlelight Tour July 24th only 8:00 pm – 9:30 pm

This program is given at Stop # 2 (you must drive there) Tour the Stone House (used as an aid station during the two battles) after dark by candlelight.
