Roof supported at wide intervals by large, squared wood columns. The west side is built into the hill. On the east side, which looks down a long slope of former pasture land to the woods along Bull Run near old McLeans Ford, the 'intrenchments of D.R. Jones' ~~brigade~~ brigade there are three great archways, each 10 feet wide and eight feet high at the apex." The floor is all concrete.

McLean proposes using haymow for a "little theatre" Barn beneath the theatre could be a historical museum, souvenir sales room, restaurant, + patio for tables overlooking Bull Run valley.
