Since I have been unable to reach you by telephone, I decided to drop you a note to let you know the present status of your house with regard to the Historic Landmarks designation. This is what I assume your inquiry is about.

As you may know, we are nearing completion of the Prince William County architectural and historic sites survey. Quite a few sites included in the survey will be candidates for the State and National Registers. The process of nominating these places will begin once the survey is finished and the final report written.

I do not know whether your house would meet the National Register criteria. I am enclosing a brochure which outlines the selection criteria. You should initiate the nomination process by writing to Calder Loth, Senior Architectural Historian, Virginia Historic Landmarks Commission, 221 Governor Street, Richmond, Va. 23219. Refer to the survey file Mill Creek Farm 76-111 in your letter.
