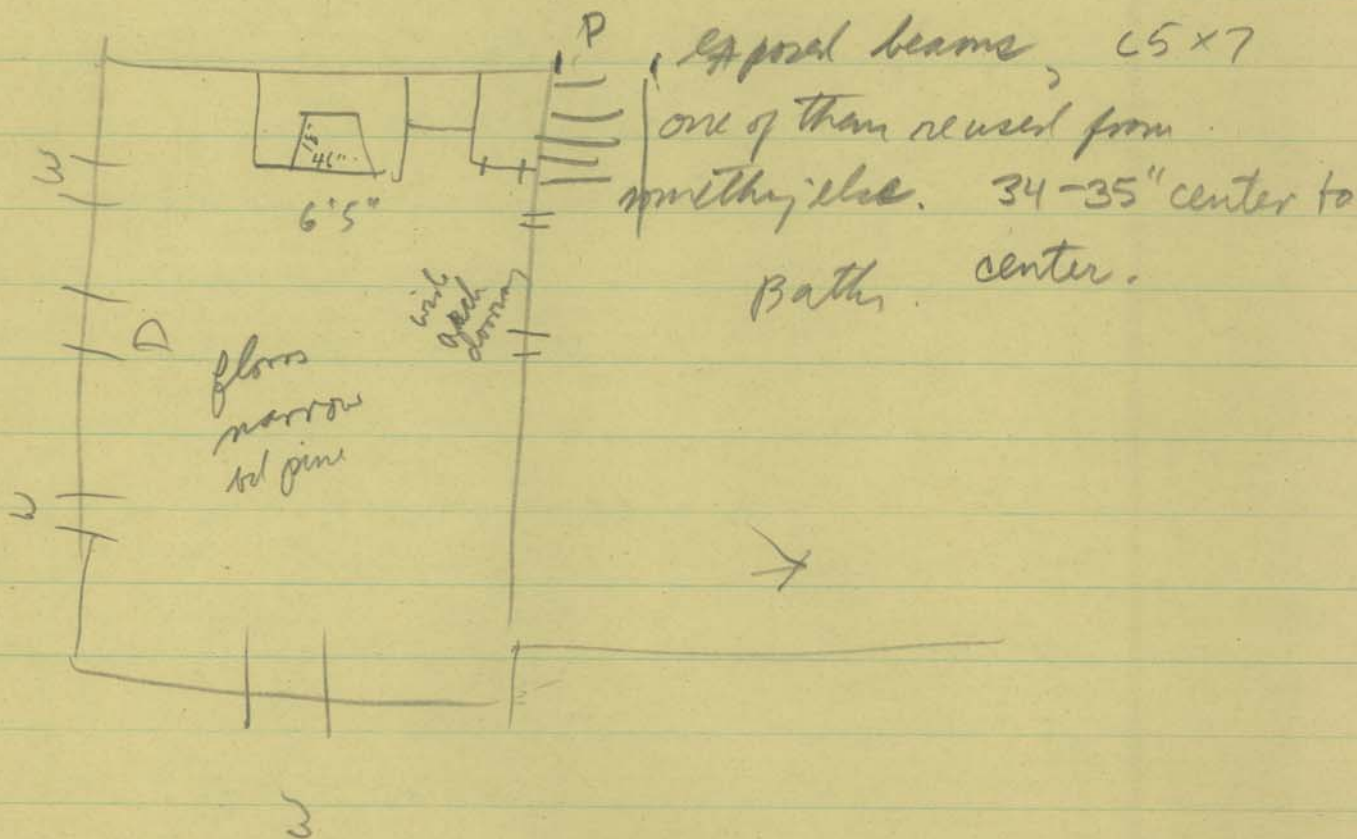
1st floor east room.

arched opening

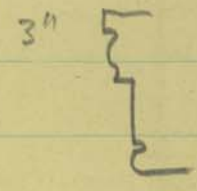
plain pilasters
