Description

Cemetery is ⁱⁿ an enclosed, fenced parcel c 100' x 100'
located about 1,200 feet off Sprigge Rd.,
at the end of an unimproved ~~res~~ private lane.
Lane is littered with trash along the way.

Beside the cemetery is a large flat
area, possibly the ~~last~~ site of the
Sacred Heart Church, which ^{in 1937} was
moved about 2 miles north to the intersection
^{known as} Token, on Hoadley Rd.

Cemetery is fairly well maintained considering its
isolated location. However, some of the markers have
been desecrated, ~~for~~ through the removal of ^{their} ornamental eastern
crosses.

History

This is not an old graveyard. It is being given special attention because the church once associated with it was moved ^{in 1937} from its original site ^{beside the cemetery} ~~in about 1937~~ to a new location about 2 miles north on Hoarley Rd.
