mill road. Mill

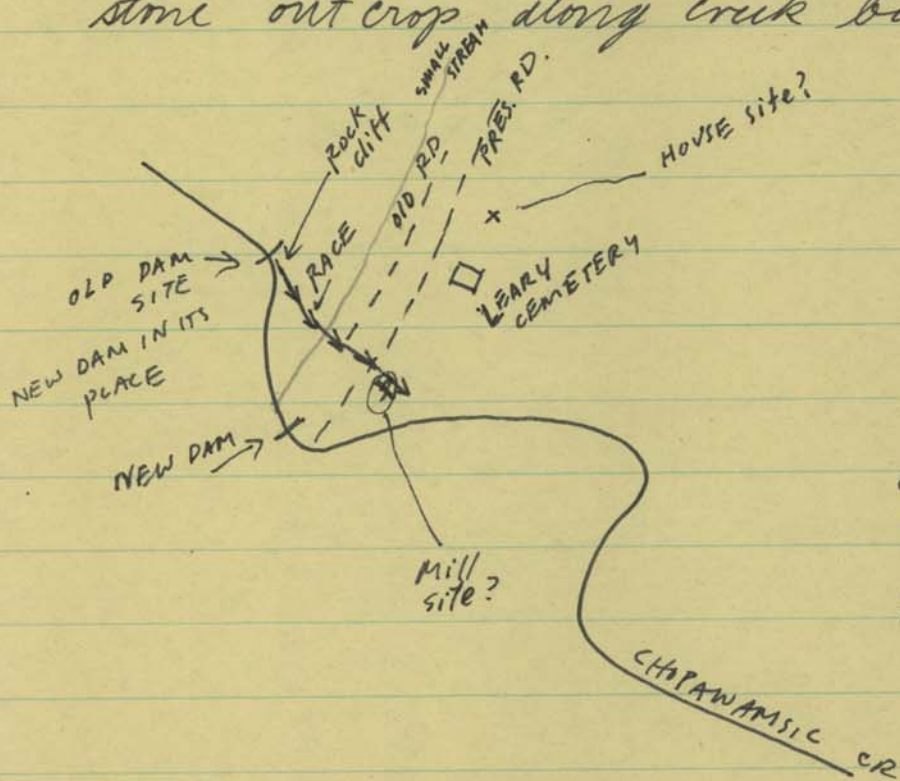
"Mill house ruins" said to be c 100 yds  
west of Leary Cemetery - no sign of any  
foundations or anything; but it was in  
this vicinity or area that E. P. Conner  
indicated he thought the mill was, not the  
house. The house, he believe, was located  
behind the cemetery on a rise or hill  
northeast of the cem. Said the marines  
had leveled the structure's foundations.

Two dams present, both <sup>at least</sup> predominantly  
concrete, one at the old ~~road~~ creek crossing (ford)  
the other further upstream.

Missouri Mill notes, cont.

Dam upstream said by E. R. C. to have been constructed on the site of old Chapman's Mill Dam, possibly using stones from the old dam.

Parts of the race are clearly visible. Race cuts across the place where the creek bends. Dug, ~~out~~ in part, <sup>out</sup> of the stone out crop along creek bed.



No indications that the race had ever been stone-lined. Wooden flume + water guide would prob. have been contr. just below the dam to guide the water into the head race.
