Historic Moor Green (circa 1815) has a fascinating history and enjoys a rural setting that is or four miles southwest of Old Town Manassas. The home has been meticulously restored and extensively updated by its present owners. It includes a beautiful new kitchen, bathroom, fan room, and mud room as well as new systems and a totally remodeled master bath and taver room.

Washington DC. It is also just a few miles south of the Innovation Office Park, which includes an expanding number of businesses: executive offices, and a soon to be opened 1,100 seat Community Performing Arts Cent

Moor Green was built by Howson Hooe just after the War of 1812 and is one of only a handful of privately owned properties in Prir William County on the National Historic Register. The history of the house is extensively documented, to include recent reports by officials from the Smithsonian an Colonial Williamsburg.



The property rests on one of the highest elevations in the county and is surrounded by acres of secluded, manicured grounds. The home was extensively restored in 1984-85 and then thoroughly renovated (to include expansion) from 2004-2006. While the home is

fully up-to-date with dual zone heating and cooling systems, modern well and septic, and a striking new country kitchen, it retains all of its original charm with high ceilings, heart pine floors, and period moldings. Simply, Moor Green now represents the finest combination of old and new, with no compromises.



This beautiful Early American brick manor home has 15 spacious and well-appointed rooms. Included are a new gourmet kitchen, tavern room, four bedrooms, three and a half baths, seven wood-burning fireplaces with original mantles, and heart-pine floors. The property also includes a detached three-car garage with approximately 800 square feet of unfinished space above. Moor Green offers an ideal combination of history, easy commuting, and modern convenience.



Main Level:

The main level is a beautiful blend of old meeting new. Most of the original part of the house has the original heart pine flooring and is well appointed with chair and crown molding. Both the living room (17X17) and dining room (15X17) are comforted by wood burning fireplaces and well articulated mantels. The living room is further complimented by built in bookcases surrounding the fireplace. There is a gentle transition to the addition featuring a family room (13X19) with heart pine floors, french doors and a full bath. Off the family room is the Tavern Room (14X15) with a fireplace, wet bar, and exposed beams. The new addition is complete with a fabulous gourmet kitchen featuring granite counters, state of the art appliances, Crown Point cabinets and heart pine flooring. A very private screened porch (21X8) is just off the kitchen for outdoor dining.





Upper Levels:

The master bedroom (18X14) is a continuation of the tradition with crown molding, heart pine floors, sunk-in closets, and a large fireplace. Even the newly renovated master bath has a fireplace and all the newest amenities. Drawn off the master bath is a large changing room/nursery. The home is further complimented by two more bedrooms on the upper level featuring original wide plank heart pine floors and large windows overlooking a very peaceful and private setting in the back.
