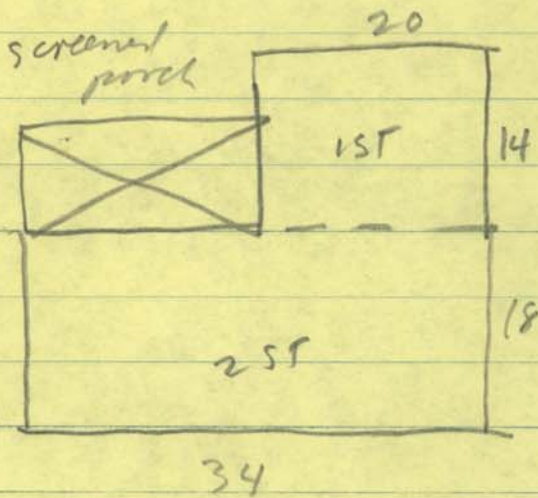

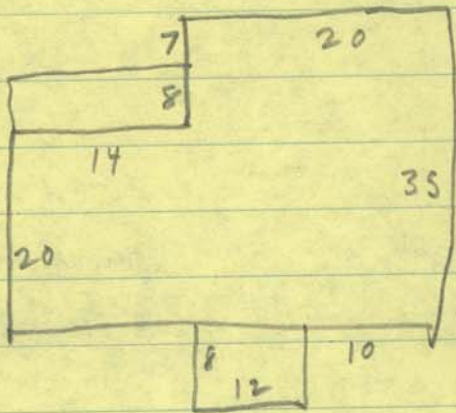

where it has been in a vault ever since except
→ restored at LOC → in 1978 - minor restoration.
→ loaned to Mount Vernon 1978

Alfred Moss, Clerk ^{Circuit Court} 1852 - 1861

Martha Washington's will was
not taken to Richmond
but left in the ^{will} picked up off
floor by Fedl. Lieutenant.
Taken home.

Brought by J.P. Morgan & placed
in his museum.

suit brought before supreme Ct.

to have it returned → 1915
Morgan returned the will before
decision was made.
