This site was identified and, ~~surveyed~~ ^{photographed} in 1971 by Col. R. Len, who placed its location about 1/2 mile southeast of the site of the Second Prince William Courthouse.

Len's survey contained only one photograph, that of the broken ~~table~~ tombstone of Mary Owen(s) (1750-1812), though possibly other burials exist on the plot.
