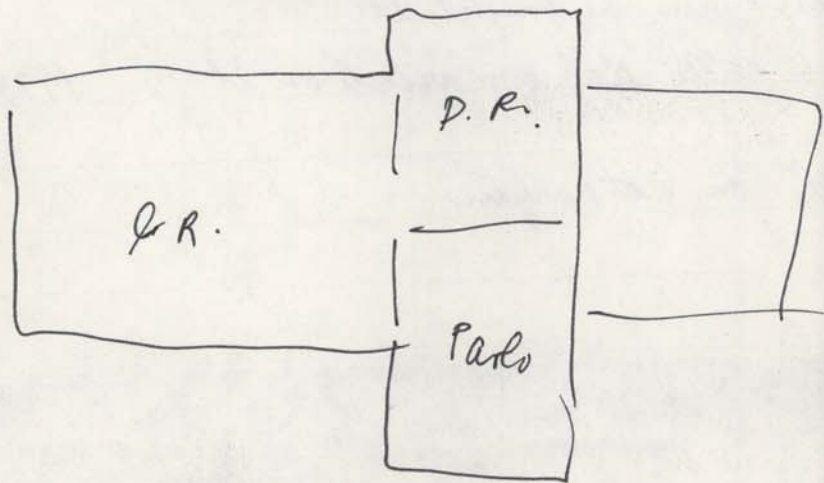

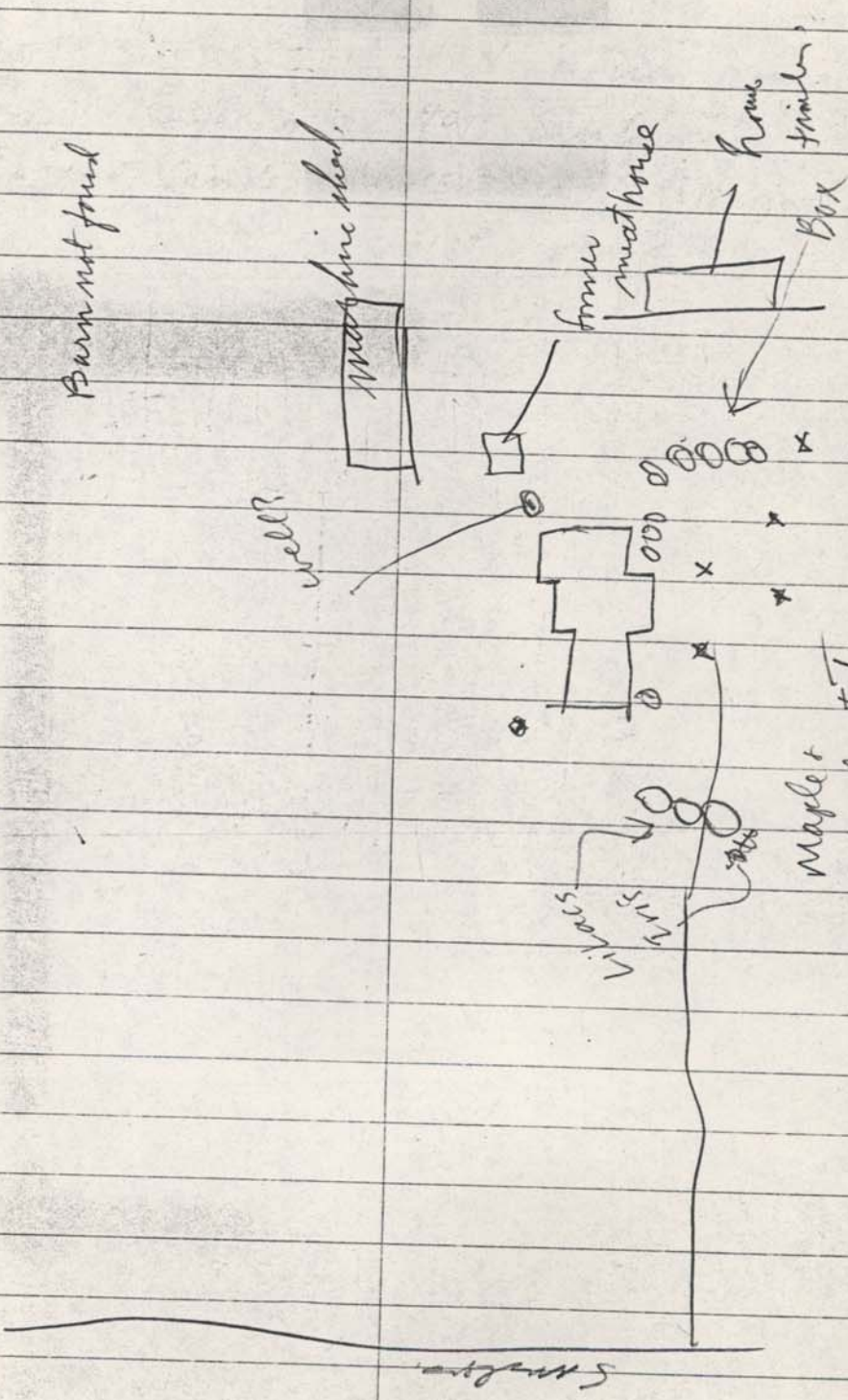

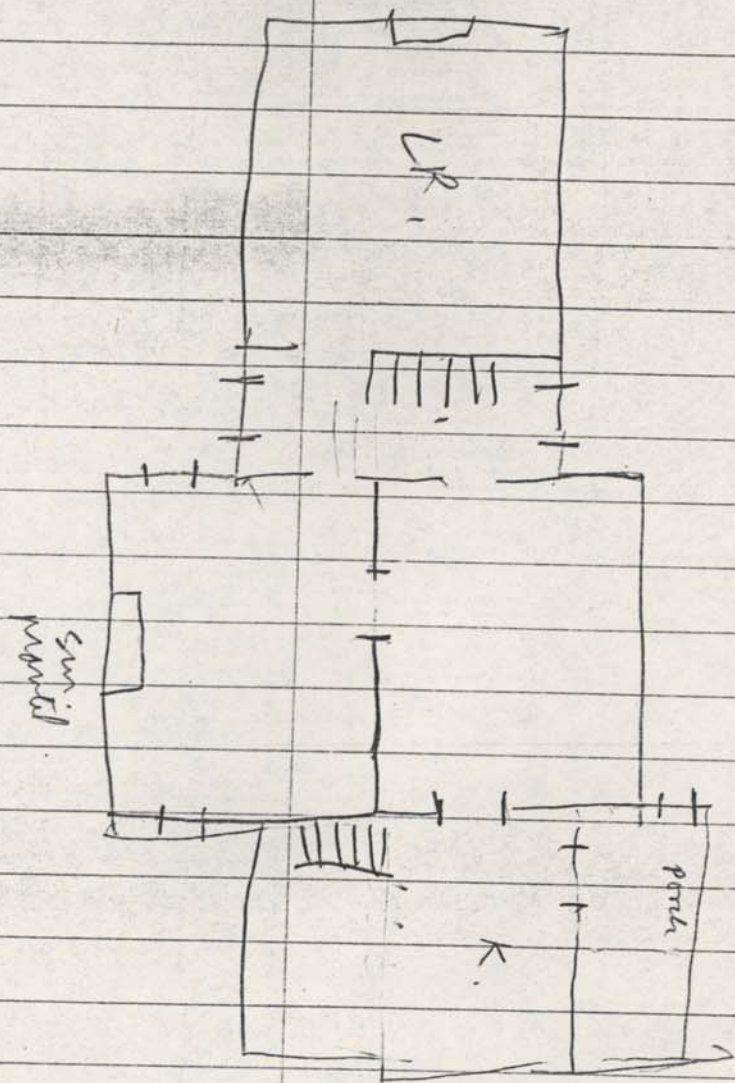

Q. prior to 1785 farms were leased in 100-acre,
in 1785 a law was passed. To enable leaseholders to

no deeds pre 1785.
