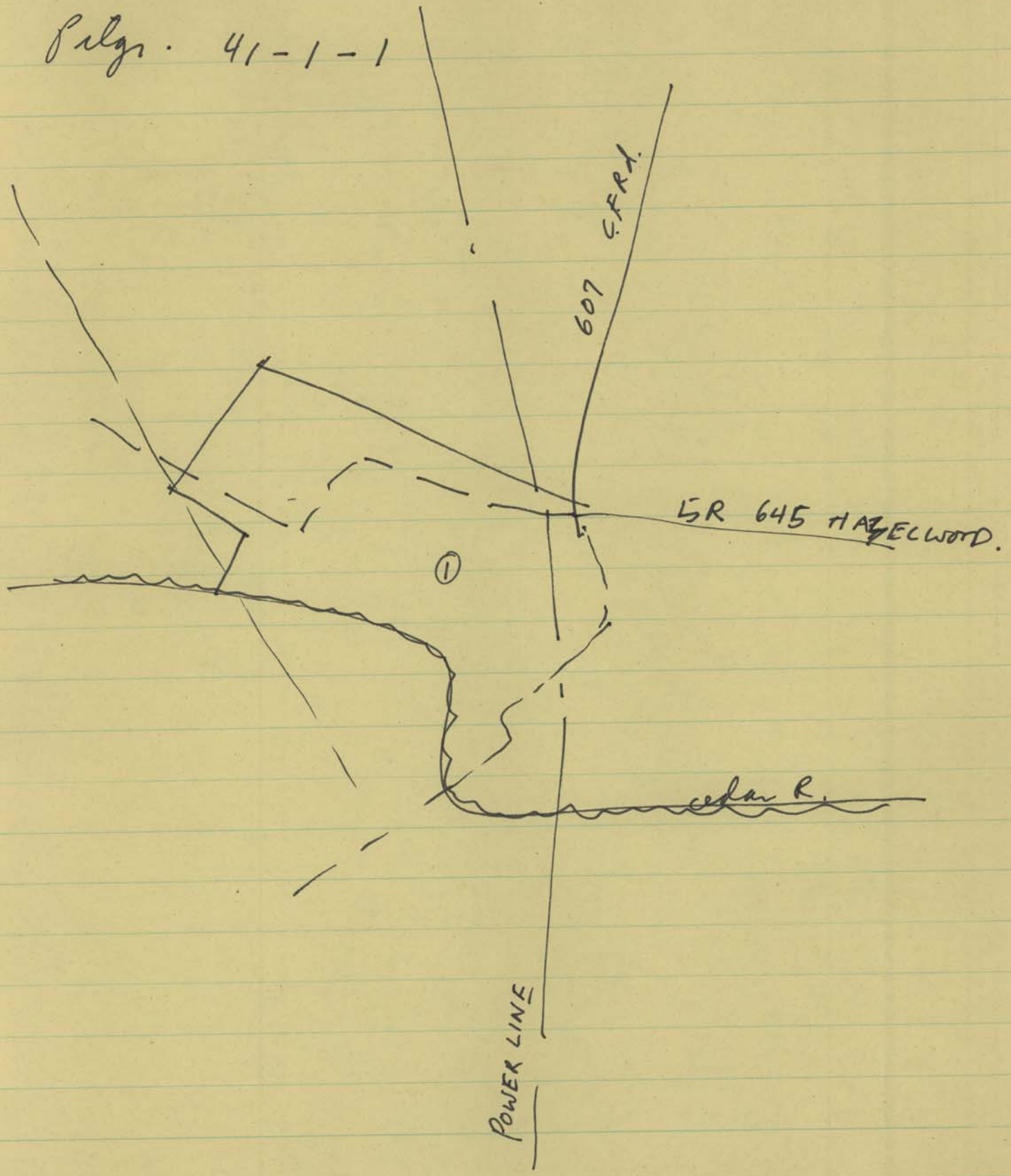

after porches were removed"

Shows main home front. 1-story addition  
(gable-roofed) with an enclosed shed  
addition on west (left) side of  
house. <sup>TOP of</sup> One of the end chimneys almost visible.

House protected by present fence  
(gate also visible) with a high tomato wire  
extension above the top of the fence.

Exterior of house is covered in ship-lap.

Windows 2/2. Trim dark, house white.

There was probably a 2-story porch  
running from the entrance and across  
the east or right side of house.

appears to have been a door 2d floor  
gable end front half of house where  
the present bathroom is and where there  
is now a window.

porch may have gone all the way across front  
and around the east corner.

On inspection, it appears that upstairs Hall  
has been divided into hall + 2 rooms - was once a  
large room with S.C. at 3d fl. at back.





## Pilgrimi Rest.

On Cedar run 3 miles east of Cattlett  
& on the county line. built 1750  
by a Fitzhugh of King Geo. County  
Land was left to Samuel Hayward  
by Nicholas Hayward, one of the  
orig proprietors of the 30,000 acre  
Brent town tract. 1000 acres  
of the Hayward Quarter was conv.  
to Henry Fitzhugh (1687-1758).  
plant. passed from Fitzhugh to  
Henry Dade Hore. In 1843, to  
Alexander Grigsby. In 1850 Levi  
Hazen acq. it. with min. who  
renamed it.

Malvin Hazen purch. the prop. & restored  
the orig name. He was a pres of Bd. of  
Commissioners of D. of C.
