In 1931 Va Publ. Serv. Co., in connection w/
a dam being constructed on Occoquan River,
condemned said prop in this Court. The Court
allowed 5000 (bids Common Law^{o.} B.

10 pp 32-131) which sum your
Complainants \$1,500 to be used to repair the C.H.
so as to make it a place of amusement for
the wh. people of P.W.C. the rest of the
5,000 is to be used for upkeep of same,
and a suitable marker placed in the
grounds as a mem. to E. J.B.T.T.
