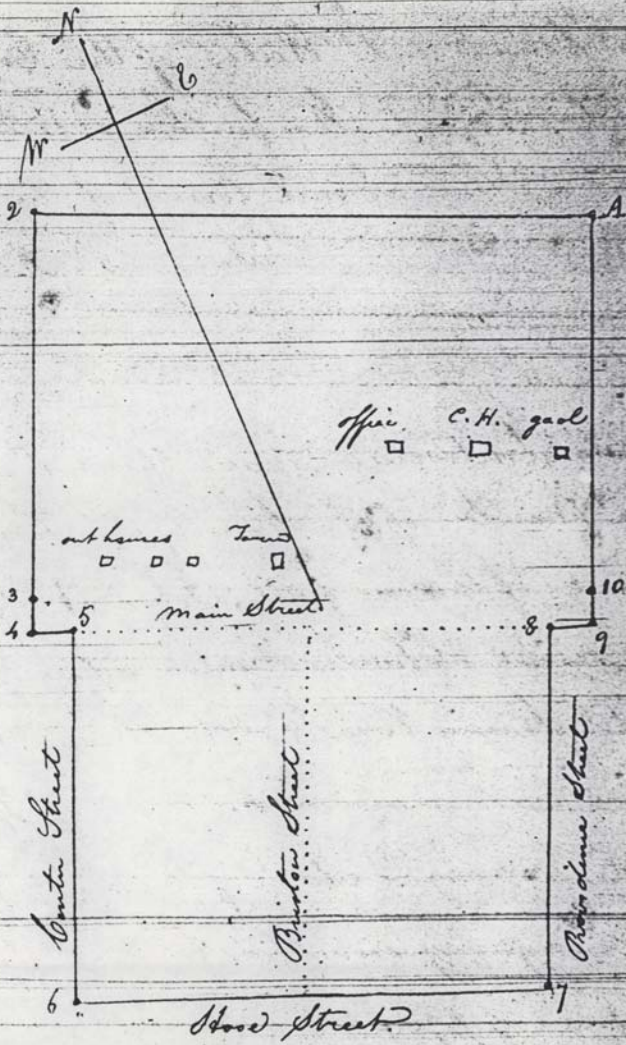


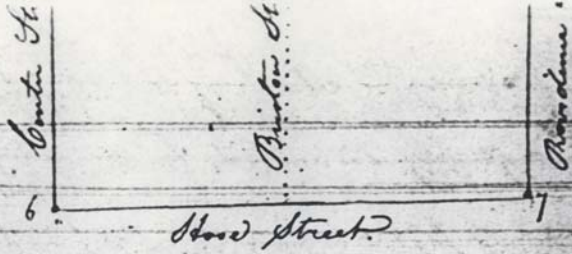

Purveyed to an order of the Court at P. M. 11. 1811



Pursuant to an order of the Hon. Court of Prince William County to me directed (bearing date 6th of November 1822) I have layed out 10 acres of land adjoining the prison of S. County as the prison bounds beginning at A. the N.E. corner of the public square thence N 66° 30' W. 38 po. to B the NW corner of Tavern lot C thence with line of the Tavern lot S 23° 30' W 25.3 po. to the corner of the S. Tavern lot at D extend the same course forty feet to the middle of the main Street in the Town of Brentville at H thence down said Street 3 poles to E thence with Center Street to Hood Street at G thence down Hood Street to Providence Street at F thence with Providence Street to the center of Main Street at 8 thence down Main Street 3 poles to 9 opposite the S.E. corner of the public

square thence 150 feet to the S^e Corner of the square at 10
from thence to the beginning & containing 10 acres of land.
