# Tour to show off 'green' energy

LOCCA, Public Works to discuss geothermal heat

It's a meeting of old with new that kicks off Saturday morning, as civic group leaders and county staff showcase the latest in environmentally friendly energy technology on two Prince William buildings that have been around for decades.

Rippon Lodge was built about 1747, according to a press release from the Lake Ridge Occoquan Coles Civic Association, and "is the oldest house in existence in Prince William County."

The Brentsville Courthouse, meanwhile, was constructed nearly 100 years earlier, "on the King James II of England Brent Town Land Grant," LOCCA reports. The building was the site of the county seat in 1820.\_
