Troop movements probably in area.

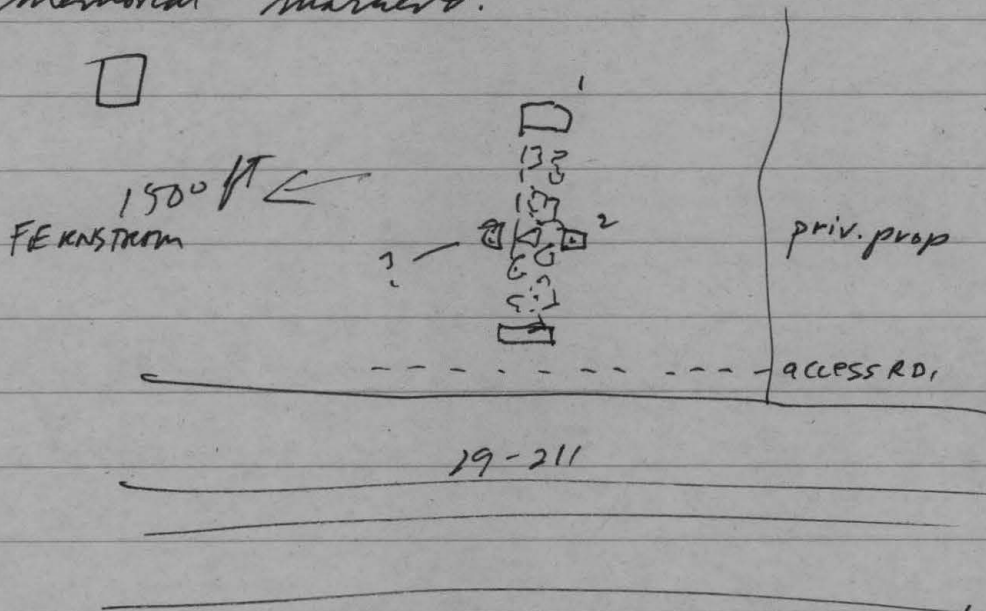
