Hearing Reset**

For the second time the Comprehensive Health Planning Council of Northern Virginia's public hearing on a Directory of Physicians has been postponed because of snow.

The new hearing is scheduled Feb. 13 at 8 p.m. in Rm. 216 of the Thomas Jefferson High School and Community Center, 125 Old Glebe Rd. in Arlington.
