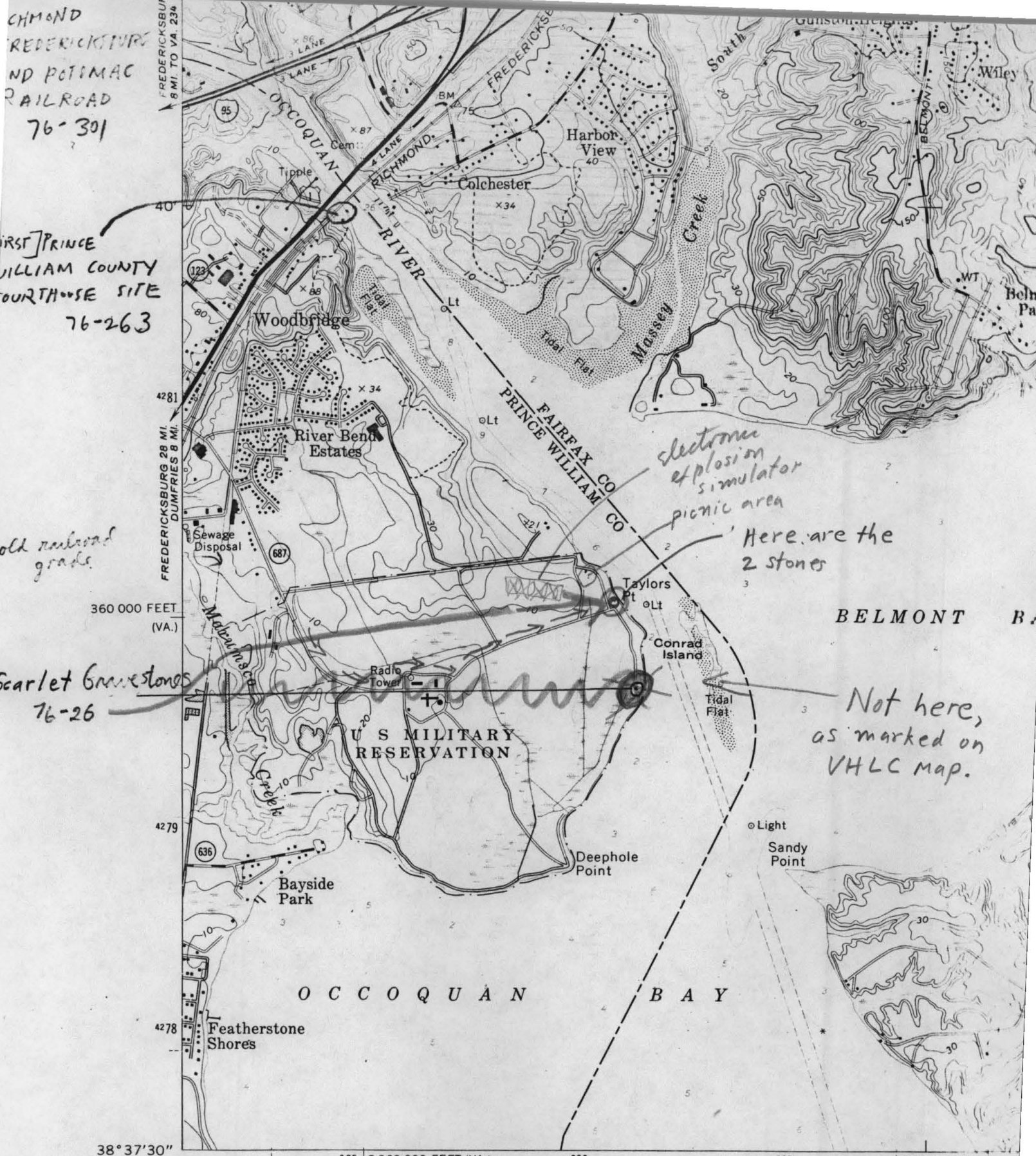

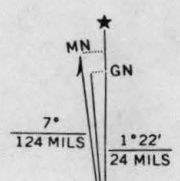

The original town was surveyed by Mr. S. from 17 of British lands sold to 1789 and by the then John Lane & included the Cott. No. 1, 2, 3, 4 & 5 Cott. -

On the corner of the old town and beginning of the new town as indicated by Mr. S. built April 2, 1792 and includes from the Cott. No. 6 to No. 166 as by the latter lines of the town and the Cott. G. H. O. 1, K. L. and the remainder of the land to the beginning of the old town by act of Assembly on the Petition of the late Capt. W. Dering on June 17th and left out in a survey made by Mr. Dering of the whole town and Cott. No. 167 with other alterations as stated by the Minutes of the St. James of Georgetown and the streets all round.
