LAND PURCHASE UPDATE

Presently the Diocese of Arlington is in the process of purchasing seven acres of land adjacent to Sacred Heart Mission Chapel. This land will be used for future development of Sacred Heart Mission as it continues to grow to the full status of a parish. We hope to go to final settlement for the purchase of the land within the next month. The land will be donated to Sacred Heart by the Diocese, but all future buildings and development must be financed by the Sacred Heart community. We will keep you informed on the progress of the land purchase.

BOND REFERENDUM

The forthcoming bond referendum on November 6 will benefit the people of Coles area in the following way:

"We will get the three fields at Independent Hill Park lighted. We will get a new park within a five-minute drive of Coles Elemen-School. In this prk we will have a 25-meter pool, gymnasium, picnic area, four lighted tennis courts, pavilion with restrooms, development of four football/soccer and three baseball/softball fields. This will be built by 1982."

WHAT IS SACRED HEART? WILL YOU HELP US GROW?

At the moment, we are a Mission Church, attached to Holy Family Parish, Dale City, and served by the priests of Holy Family. To be a member of Sacred Heart, you must register as such. We have our own collection which goes into the Sacred Heart Fund, our own Parish Advisory Board, and our own CCD program. To learn more about Sacred Heart, come to our meeting on Sunday, October 7, at Coles School immediately following the 8:30 a.m. Mass.

Sacred Heart Mission now has a registered membership of 142 families and continues to grow rapidly. We ask all members who belong to our community to support us by sacrifical giving of your time, talents, and financial resources. There are many opportunities for your generosity -- our CCD program, liturgy committee, and parish maintenance groups are always in need of your help.

The usual method of Church support is through the regular use of Church envelopes. Presently we average about 35 envelopes a week for an approximate collection of \$350 a week. I ask each family to prayerfully consider their present method of supporting our Church. If you are not receiving Church envelopes, call our Church office, 670-8161, and be sure you are on our mailing list. If you are receiving envelopes and are not using them, then please give prayerful consideration to regular weekly use of offertory envelopes.

In order to continue our service of the people and continued development of our Mission Chapel, we still need the generous self-gifing of each member - that self-giving can come by the donation of time, talents and financial resources.
