

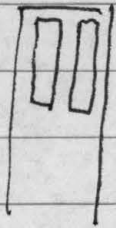

Front door replaced.

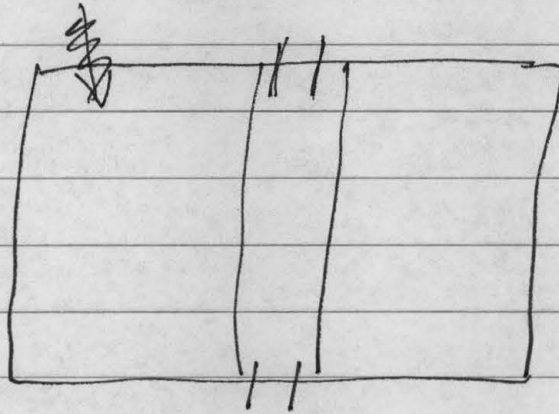
