Grant of 30,000 acres from James II in 1686-87 for a rel. sanctuary
A town known as Brent Town or Brenton
was established in 1688 by George Brent
Richard Foote + Robert Bristow, ^{Nicholas Hayward,} recip. of the grant.

A block house built there in 1688
Exact loc. of Brent Town not known, except
that town overlooked the Indian trail,
later the Carolina Rd., forcing Indians to cut
a new path further westward.

Suspected it is loc. in U.S. Mar. Corps. base
possibly on prop (quadrant) owned by
Richard Foote. Another location was Landsdowne.

E.R.C. believes Brent Town is loc in ^{area} presently
designated ~~of~~ by U.S.M.C. as 11A (or 11B).
