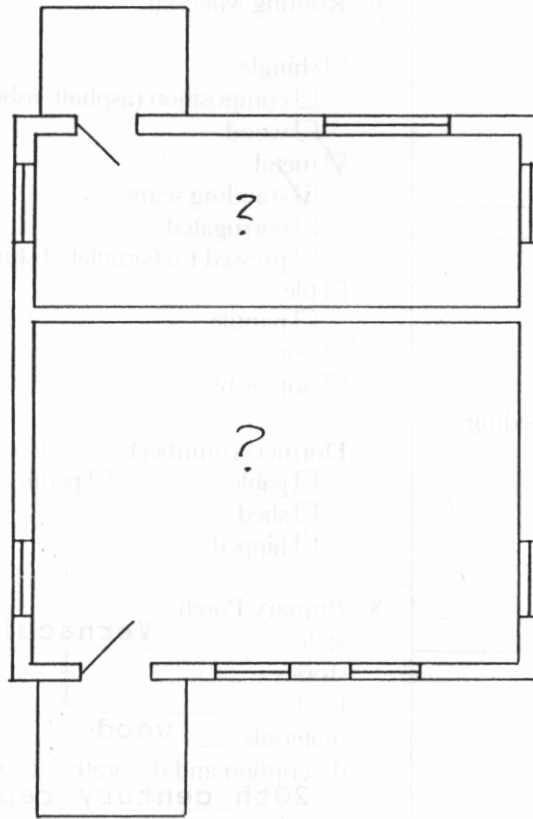

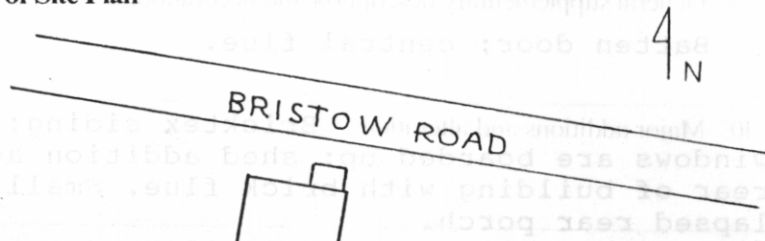

Sketch of Site Plan

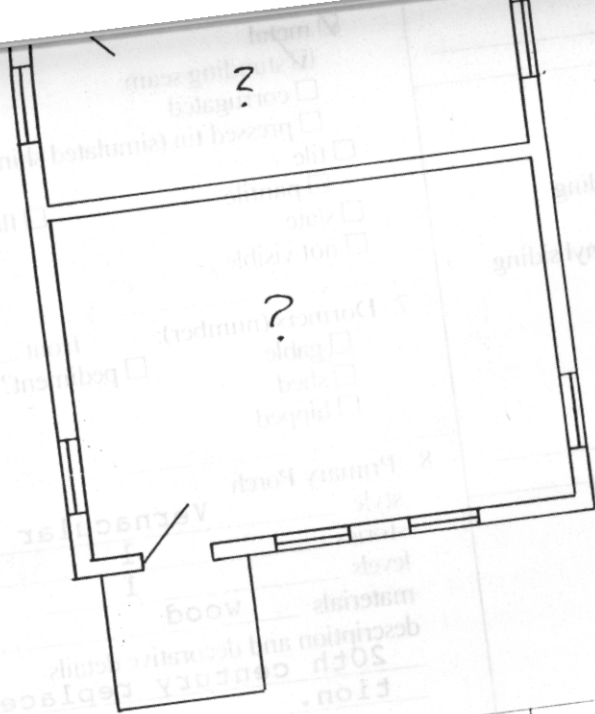
