William H. Brown House in 1901 (Wm. Brown Map 1901). One of few Italianate houses in the area. Vacant and in poor condition.

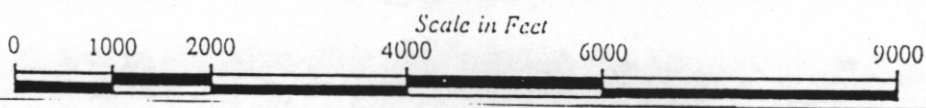
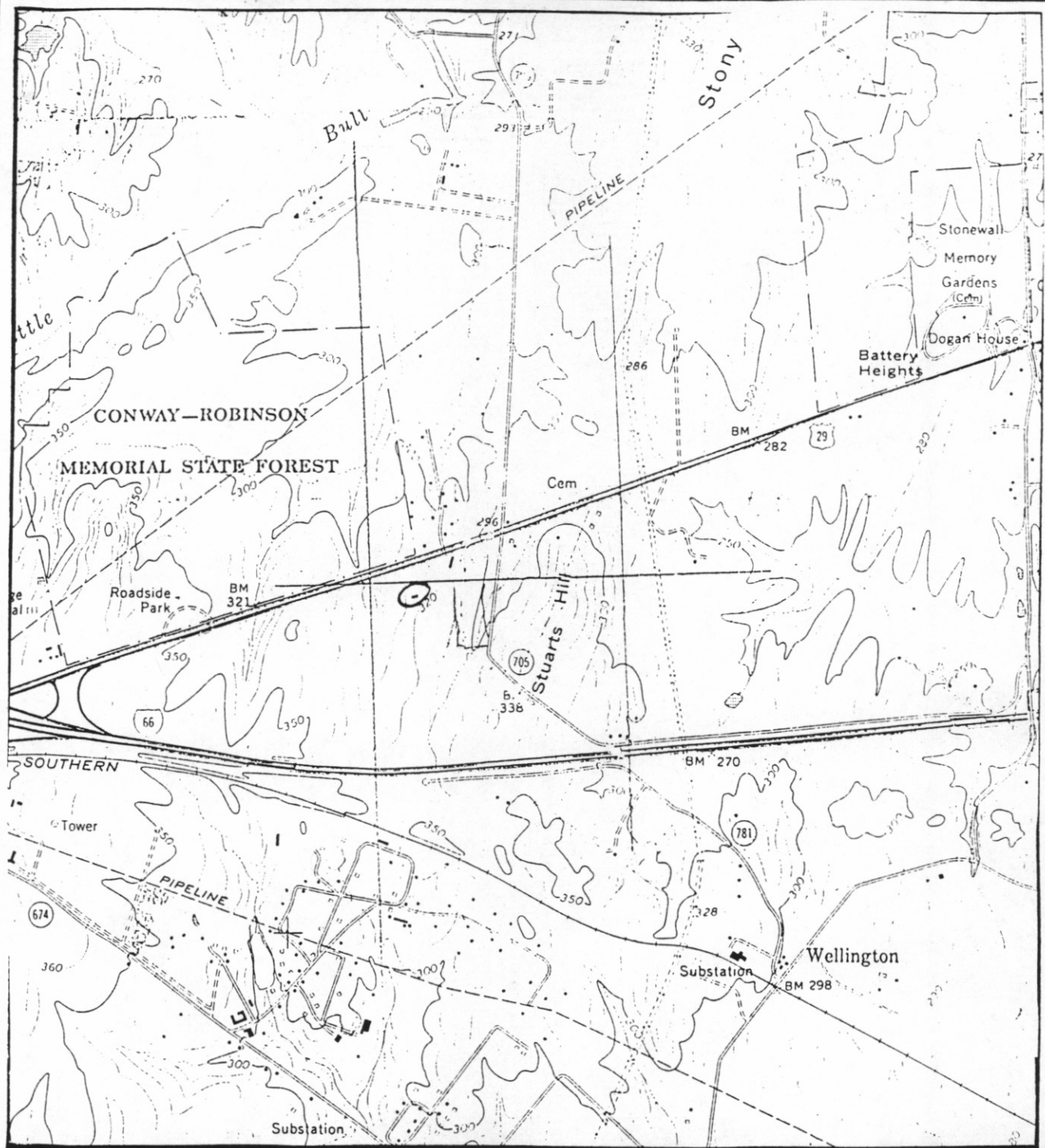
