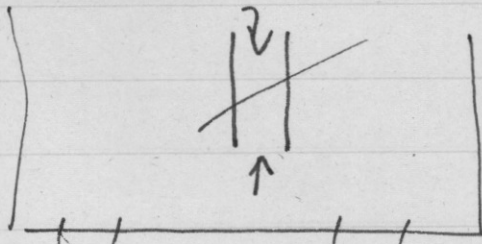

stone steps led to it. There was a small porch or landing at entrance. Floors are wide & old looking.

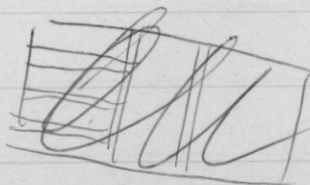
some old board & batten doors; other doors are 24" / 1" panel doors

ceilings very high -

stair winds at upper end
fairly wide stair case,
wood tread. square posts, bails & rail
2 finished rooms & hall 2d fl.
mantel shelf in west room.
but fireplace not working (stone pipe)

basement has cement floor, newly-added stair to basement. Formerly only outside entrance to cellar
no signs of fireplace in basement, but stone been worked on, & possibly there is one; if so, maybe on the west wall.

Heavy heavy beams support the 1st floor.
