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To the Legislature of Virginia

The petition of Samuel M. Jarney and Saml.
H. Jarney of the Town of Occoquan & County of Prince
William respectfully represents to the General
Assembly of Virginia. —

That your petitioners are
the proprietors of a Cotton Factory at Occoquan, which
has been in operation some years, but is not yet filled
with machinery and your petitioners wish to associate
with themselves other persons who will furnish addi-
tional Capital and enable us to fill up the building
with machinery, which would render the business
more profitable to ourselves & more advantageous to
the neighborhood. — This additional investment
of Capital ~~of Capital~~ we cannot proceed with-
out an act of Incorporation which we
respectfully solicit the Legislature to grant.
