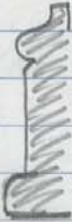

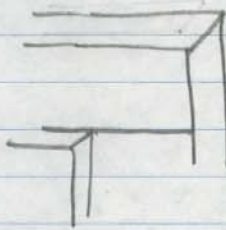
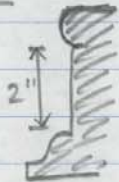

Fixtures for shutters; shutters may.

A 1-story shed roof addition w/ concrete foundation on ^{west} north side of 1912 el.

Prob contained a bathroom, judging by plumbing fixtures.

Also a 1-story gable roofed addition c8'x12' off the ^{west} east gable of 1912 el. Shelters a rectangular concrete slab & may have been the well house.

Interior: heavy timber ^{framing} (post & beam construction w/ corner braces) later reinforced. Furring replaced for new bath.

Rm 1: Fireplace: brick ^{twice?} made smaller. Mantel missing. Sills = 10" wide.

Exterior: Foundation: coursed rubble. Basement only under 20th c el.

Basic house shape is an el, with the el, or later section, projecting from the front left of earlier house. Earlier section is 3 bays, 2¹/₂ stories with central passage and stone end chimney 2/3 of way up, then becoming brick. El is 5 bays long w/ 2 stove flues.

1 story ^{Victorian} porch runs 2/3 of way across front & intersects with similar porch across front of addition. The seam where porch roofs are joined is visible.

There is a collapsed 1-story ^{Victorian} porch on rear with indication that there was a 2d story balcony. The porch would have been reached through a window converted to a door.

Doors: f. door missing, swing to the right / Transom & side lights. Same for door on addition.

Windows: Plain with moulded lintel (cornice).

Panes missing.

Roof is raised seam metal.

Box cornice.

Exterior covered with channeled siding, lapped 5."

2d fl. room 6 (over l. side)

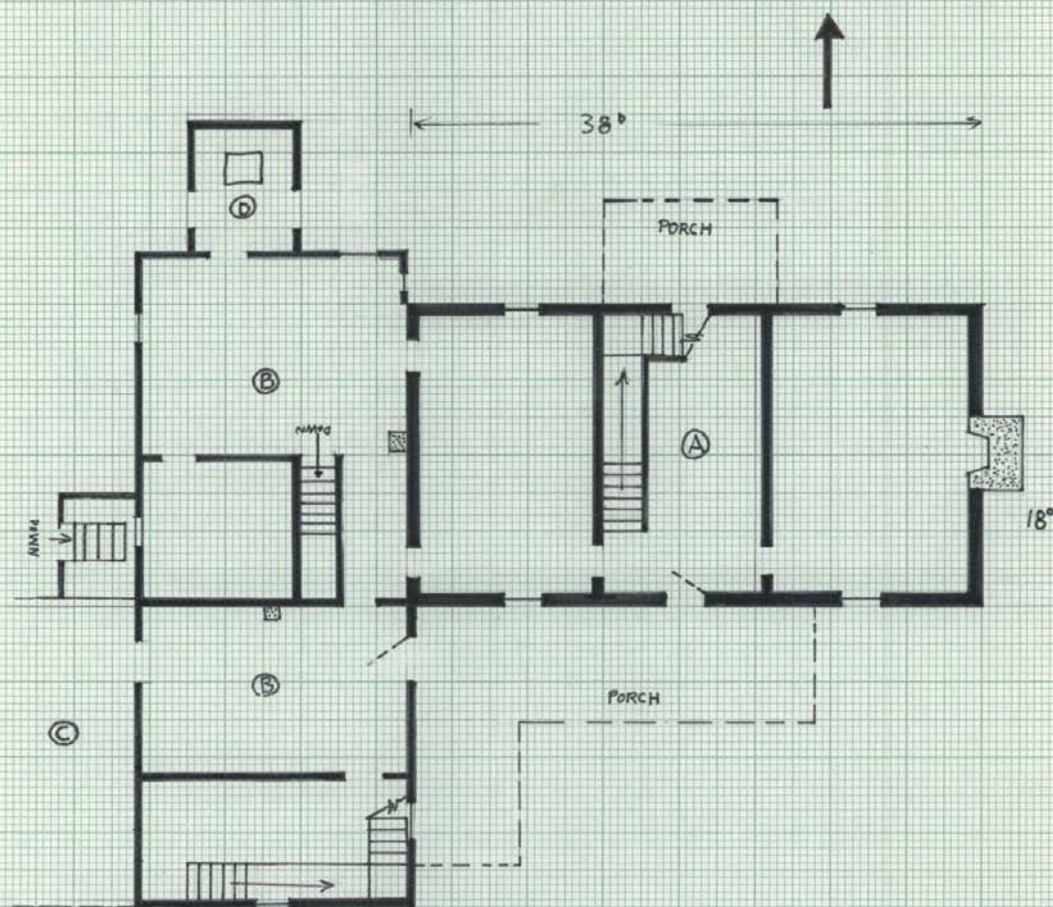
Room is undecorated.

Attic over older section is finished in narrow
tongue + groove boards. Recently occupied.

Details of plan.

1. Front doors (2) ^{missing.} Both swing to the right. Have transom and sidelights. Sills here are 10" wide.
2. Fireplace; mantel missing. Opening made smaller twice.
3. Heavy timber framing with corner braces visible. Studs later reinforced. Furring strips replaced for new lath.
