

Mr Voigt, acting Park supervisor,

House.

At one time they considered using the  
Doyan House for a PS employees  
residence, adding heat + plumbing,  
but that is not being considered  
any more. The place has been used  
for ~~day~~ craft demonstrations  
but without water, it's hard to use  
it for much of anything.

The Henry House ~~is~~ is out of time context  
for the battlef. park history. it having been  
built after the war.

It may rest on the early Henry House  
foundation.

The house is said to have been built in  
two parts, the 1870's section, the  
main part of the house by Andrew Norman,  
and a later 2-story addition is supposed  
to have been built in the 1880's.

## Stonewall Jackson monument -

Erected 1920?

Statue location was a figment  
of landscape architect's imagin.  
Jackson's stand was  
actually south<sup>east</sup> of the spot  
from where the statue is.  
Not on the crest of the hill  
but behind the crest.

Hist. markers give impression  
that Conf. were on the crest  
but they weren't.
