We found a deed (DB 28:562) made the 17th April 1872 between Grayson Tyler and Sallie Grayson for \$100 for a parcel of land in PWC beginning at an old oak post on the east side of the Carolina road and running N87 E 21 ½ poles to a stake in the field thence N28 E 50.5 po to another stake near a spring. Thence N68 W 10 po: to Hulfish's line, thence with his line S39 W 11/12 to said Hulfish's corner, thence N50 W 12.5 po: to a locust tree on east side of Carolina Road, thence with said S26 W33 po: S11 W20 poles to the beginning and contains seven acres and 34 poles, together with all and singular the tenements and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining and the revision and revisions, remainder and remainders, [?] issues and profit thereof and also all the estate, right, [?] interest, property, possession claim and demand whatsoever, as with in law as in equity of the said part.....Randolph Tyler [witness]

Perhaps that's the property?

This Indenture made the twentieth day of April in the year One thousand
eight hundred and seventy two Between Grayson Tyler of the first part
and Sallis Grayson of second part all of the County of Prince William and
State of Virginia. Witnesseth that the said party of the first part for and
consideration of the sum of One hundred dollars lawful money of the United
States of America to him in hand paid, by the said party of the second part, at
or before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, aliened, remised, released, conveyed and
confirmed, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, alien, remise, release, con-
vey and confirm, unto the said party of the second part and to her heirs and
assigns all the following described parcel of land lying in the County of Prince William
and State of Virginia, Beginning at an old Gate post on the west side of the Caro-
lina road and running N 87 E 21 1/2 poles to a stake in the field thence N 68 E
50.5 po to another stake near a spring, thence S 68 W 10 po to Mulfish's line, thence
with his line S 39 W 11 1/2 to said Mulfish's corner, thence N 50 W 12.5 po to a locust
tree on east side of Carolina Road, thence with said S 26 W 33 po: S 11 W 20 poles to
the beginning and contains seven acres and 24 poles, together with all and singular
the tenements and appurtenances therunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and
the reversion and reversions, remainder and remainders, rents issues and profits thereof
And also all the estate, right, title interest, property, possession claim and demand
whatsoever, as well in law as in equity of the said party of the first part, of in, or
to the above described premises, and every part and parcel thereof, with the appurtenan-
ces, Do have and to hold all and singular the above mentioned and described prem-
ises, together with the appurtenances unto the said party of the second part and
her heirs and assigns forever. In witness whereof the said party of the first part
has hereunto set his hand and seal this twentieth day of April One thou-
sand eight hundred and seventy two
