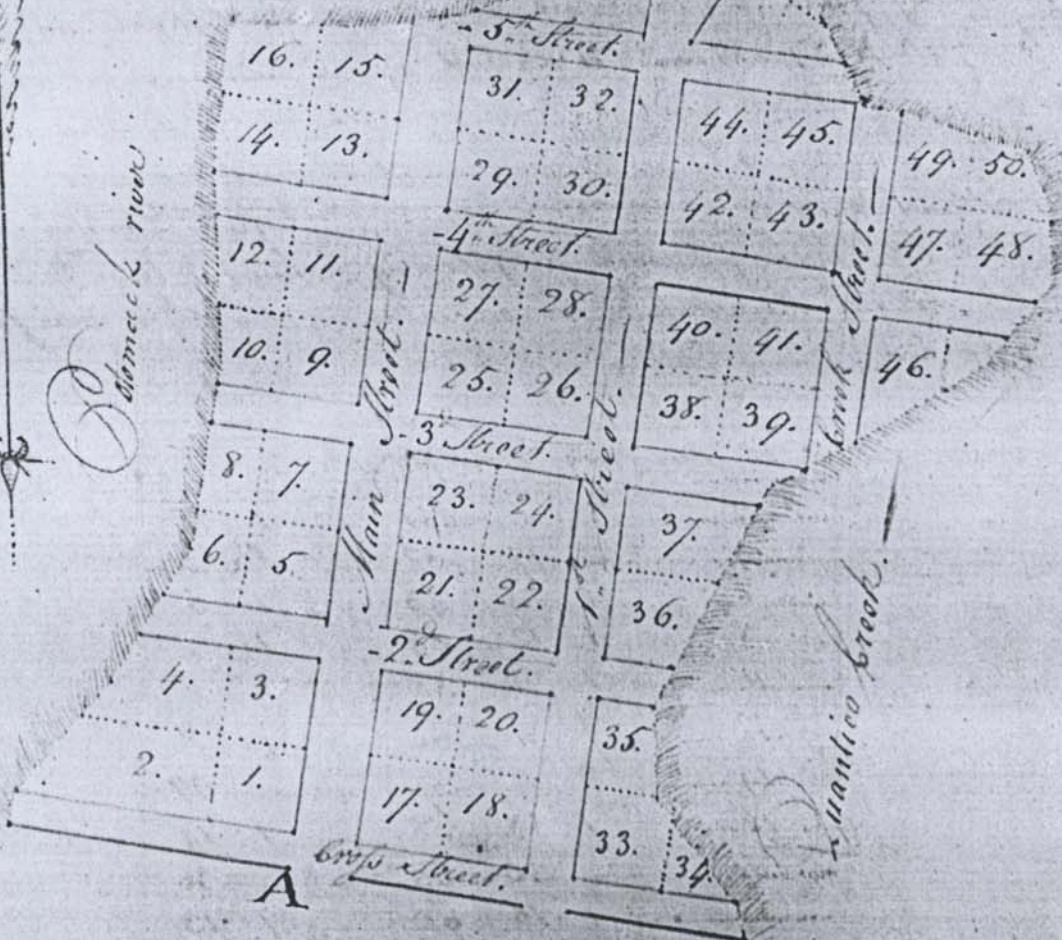

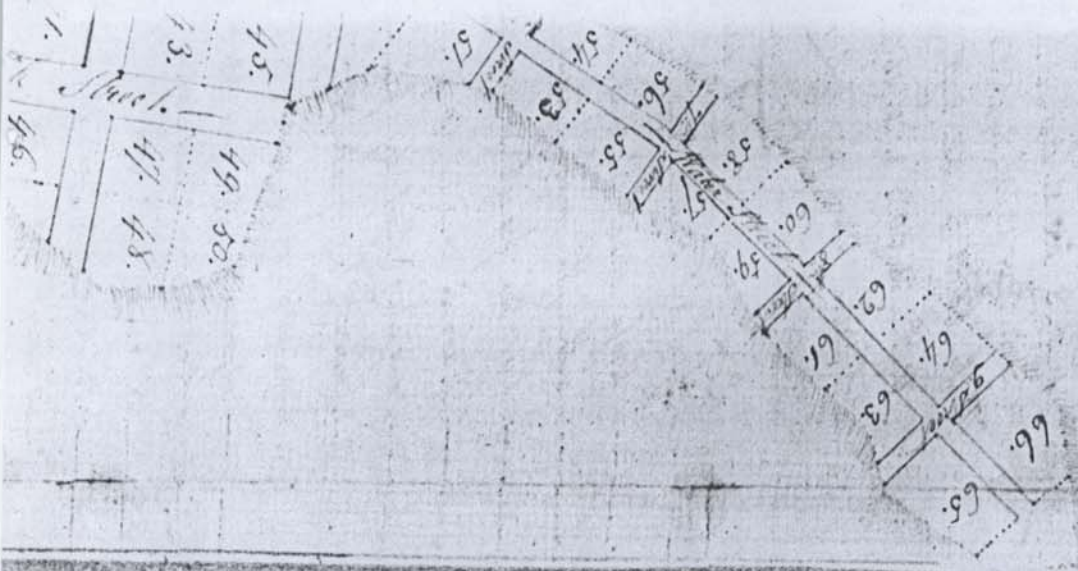

New York, January 24th June 1888. as follows.

Beginning at A a corner post & the beginning of the town, thence S 11° West 87 p. 17 links to another corner post on ditto mark river, thence N 97° SE. 55 p. 23 p. S. 85° SE. 17 p. N 11° DE. 14 p. N 22° E. N 11° DE. 20 p. N 34° DE. 16 p. N 47° DE. E. 19 p. 12 L. at right angles with the beginning. thence N 79° DE. 32 p. to the log; containing in all 82 p. to Quaker's Creek, thence down the said creek S 37° DE. 18 p. to L. S. 30 m. 18 p. S 29° 30' DE. 26 p. S. 67° DE. 14 p. S. 58° DE. 12 p. S. 42° DE. 10 p. S. 48° DE. 8 p. S. 20° DE. 6 p. S. 70° DE. 18 p. S. 24° DE. 10 p. S. 128° 30 m. W. 17 p. S. 40° DE. 20 p. S. 23° DE. 8 p. S. 59° DE. 12 p. S. 45° DE. 14 p. S. 70° 30 m. W. 7 p. S. 37° DE. 14 p. thence crossing the point S 38° E. 8 p. thence up the river N 80° 30 m. E. 16 p. N 43° SE. 18 p. N 35° SE. 20 p. N 50° 30 E. 16 p. N 35° 15 m. E. 9 p. N 22° 15 m. E. 12 p. N 52° 30 m. E. 18 p. to the river ferry landing. N 71° 45 m. E. 20 p. N 57° SE. 3 p. 22 L. to the face of the river, measuring 44 acres of land, the streets (overlaid by plain red lines) are: Main street 100 feet wide, first street & creek street 80 feet wide, & all run parallel S 11° DE. The cross streets are marked by plain red lines & noted as, Long street 2, 3, 4, 5 & streets are each 66 feet wide, & run at right angles with the main street from river to creek N 79° DE. The first running thro' the point from the obstruction of just of the point is 33 feet wide & bears S 36° DE. 40 p.; then extending S 46° DE. 60 p. to the point. The streets crossing that by plain red lines are 33 feet wide & at right angles from river to creek N 54° DE. Each full square contains two acres, and each quarter of a square contains half an acre as laid off by both laws, the lots adjoining the river & creek as its number lots as laid out. The front lots left without number at the point, for the creek ferry landing, contains 1100 square feet, that left blank for river ferry landing contains 2 rods 20 back, the blank lots between the creek & the corner of 1st 5th & 6th streets contains 1 rod 28 back.

 parallel S 11° D W. - The cross streets also marked by plain red lines & noted, as,
 Cross street 2^d. 3^d. 4th. & 5th. Streets are each 66 feet wide, & run at right angles
 with the main street from river to Creek N 79° D W. - The street running
 thro' the point from the intersection of first & fifth streets is 33 feet wide &
 bears S 36° D W, 40 p^{ts}. then extending S 46° D W, 60 p^{ts}. to the point. - The streets
 crossing that by plain red lines are 33 feet wide & at right angles from
 river to Creek N 54° D W. - Each full square contains two acres, and each
 quarter of a square contains half an acre as laid off by dotted lines, the lots
 adjoining the river & Creek as ft. number lots in list subjoined. - The small
 lots left without number at the point, for the Creek ferry Landing, contains 1 rood
 8 perches, that left blank for river ferry Landing contains 2 rood 20 perches, the
 blank lots between the Creek & the connection of 1st 5th & water streets contains
 1 rood 28 perches.
